An Important Note on Attendance

As we come closer to Recital and are working more intensely on choreography, consistent attendance is crucial. Please make sure your dancer is present and on time for **every** class for the remainder of the year, unless there is a serious illness or emergency. Text 804-322-9902 to notify us in advance of any absences so our instructors can plan accordingly.

Our official attendance policy is that Kids in Motion, Recreational, and Adult dancers may only miss a total of 4 classes from January through June in order to perform in the Recital. Accelerated Program dancers may miss an individual class only twice in this period. This policy is in place for two reasons. First, it's extremely difficult for a student to progress and to retain technique and choreography with inconsistent attendance. Second, this also affects the other dancers in class, as we have to go back to review old material when students are absent, rather than moving forward.

Thank you for helping our dancers succeed by attending class every week!

Program Ad Sales Competition

Be on the cover of the Recital Program and win a year of FREE tuition!

DEADLINE TO SUBMIT ADS: Friday, May 5th 8:30pm

One of the highlights of our Recital is a beautiful program book that showcases our students. Each dancer receives a program when they arrive on Recital Day, and reading through the book is an annual dressing room pre-show tradition. Families are encouraged to support their dancers by buying and selling program ads. Ads can include pictures, words of wisdom, best wishes, and congratulations for a year of hard work and a job well done on stage. Ask your family, friends, grandparents, aunts, and uncles to sponsor an ad for your dancer. You can also ask local businesses to advertise their goods and services or to support your dancer!

GRAND PRIZE

The family with the highest dollar amount in sales (minimum \$650) will win one FREE year of tuition for the following dance season for one weekly class (up to \$838 value). Does not include performance fees, summer classes, guest artists, or workshops.

SECOND PLACE PRIZE

The family with the second highest dollar amount in sales (minimum \$400) will win one FREE Performance Fee for next year's Recital (\$195 value).

THIRD PLACE PRIZE

The family with the third highest dollar amount in sales (minimum \$300) will win one FREE month of tuition for the following dance season for ONE class of any length (up to \$92 value).

COVER PHOTO!

EVERY DANCER who sells over \$200 of ads will be featured on the cover of this year's Recital program! Must be present during Picture Week to be on the cover.

- Costumes are tried on in class as shipments arrive. Dancers who registered in Dec/Jan may have costumes arriving in a later shipment.
- Costumes should NOT be worn for <u>any</u> reason except for Picture Day, Dress Rehearsals, Tech Rehearsals, and Recital Day. Costumes CANNOT be replaced if damaged or lost.
- Costumes will be sent home in mid-April with specific instructions. Costumes will be sent home
 ONLY if family's account is current.
- **ALTERATIONS**: AIM does most costume alterations as part of your Performance Fee. Some small costume alterations may be the responsibility of the parent. This may include attaching straps, hemming skirts/pants, etc. Costumes with significant sizing issues will be sent back to the manufacturer for size exchange if shipping time allows. You will receive a note with your dancer's costume if you are responsible for any alterations.
- <u>UNDERGARMENTS</u>: <u>NUDE LEOTARD/BLACK BRIEFS</u>. ALL DANCERS MUST WEAR SPECIFIC UNDERGARMENTS UNDER THEIR COSTUMES. <u>Regular underwear is not permitted</u> <u>underneath costumes</u>. Female dancers wear nude leotards and male dancers wear black dance shorts. These undergarments keep costume changes quick, easy, and modest backstage in crowded dressing rooms. These items are **not** included in your performance fee, but can be purchased at AIM for a reasonable price. Dancers who wear two-piece costumes or wish to wear bras must purchase a nude/flesh toned dance bra and nude performance underwear from a dance retailer. We recommend Ellman's Dancewear or discountdance.com.
- TIGHTS: If required for your dancer's costume, one pair of tights is included with the costume.
 Tights are to be worn over the nude leotard. We recommend having an extra pair of tights on hand in case one pair gets a run! See the front desk to purchase extra tights.
- FINALE COSTUME: All dancers perform in the Finale. Finale Costume is:
 - AIM PROVIDES Recital T-Shirt (T-Shirts will be handed out once they arrive in April or May).
 - **DANCER PROVIDES** Solid black pants, any length/style, no jeans, no lettering, no designs.
 - Bare feet
- **COVER-UP:** Students must wear a cover-up over their costumes at all times while waiting to perform/rehearse. A bathrobe or oversized button-up shirt from Mom or Dad works well. (Shirts that have to be pulled over the head are not allowed as they will mess up hair and makeup.)
- THE FOLLOWING ARE PROHIBITED DURING PICTURE DAY, REHEARSALS, & RECITAL:
 - GLITTER
 - Jewelry of any kind (<u>please do NOT get your dancer's ears pierced in the 8 weeks before the Recital!</u>)
 - Nail polish on fingers or toes
 - Temporary tattoos
 - Underwear (approved performance undergarments only, see above)
 - Tights with runs or holes
- All belongings (costumes, shoes, Finale costume pieces, etc.) must be clearly labeled with dancer's name.

Hair & Makeup

- Dancers are required to have hair and makeup done for pictures, rehearsals, and Recital Day.
- Hair is done to keep dancers' appearance neat and tidy, and to keep hair out of dancers' faces while they're dancing.
- Makeup is done so that the audience can see dancers' facial features and expressions on stage. The bright stage lights will wash out your dancer's face if they're not wearing any makeup.
- We want your dancer to feel comfortable and confident on stage. If you are opposed to your dancer wearing makeup, please speak to Miss Casey.
- **PRACTICE**, **PRACTICE**! Don't wait until Picture Week to do your dancer's hair and makeup for the first time! Waiting until the last minute will result in stress for you AND your dancer.
- For detailed hair and makeup instructions, scan the QR code to the right, or go to artsinmotionda.com/recital.
- Adult Tap performers may wear their hair in any style, as long as it is out of the face.

- No regular classes this week. See below schedule.
- <u>Arrive at least 15 minutes before scheduled picture time wearing costume, tights & accessories, with hair & makeup done.</u>
- Pictures are being taken by local photography company Gianna Grace Photography. Ordering info will be sent out via email closer to Picture Week.
- Due to the busy nature of this event and the number of dancers in the building, **parents must** wait outside of the building while students are being photographed.
- Students in more than one dance must wear performance undergarments (see pg 5) and will change costumes the staff room. Staff will be available to assist dancers with changing if needed.
- Dancers should come to their class picture time even if parents do not plan on ordering prints so that they can be included in the group photo.
- The "Open Portraits" session on Friday at 4:30pm is reserved for dancers who are unable to attend their scheduled class picture time but still want individual portraits. Email casey@artsinmotionda.com to reserve your spot.

- No regular classes this day.
- Arrive ON TIME wearing Finale costume: nude leotard/black briefs, black pants (any length, no jeans, no designs or lettering), AIM Recital t-shirt, bare feet.
- Full hair and make-up are NOT required for this rehearsal.
- Kids in Motion dancers are NOT required to attend, but are welcome to join if they have an older sibling attending.
- ATTENDANCE FOR ALL OTHER PERFOMERS (Recreational, Accelerated. Adult) IS
 MANDATORY. DANCERS WHO DO NOT ATTEND WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO PERFORM IN
 THE RECITAL. Email casey@artsinmotionda.com right away if you have any conflicts.
- Due to the number of dancers we will have in the studio at one time for this rehearsal, **parents may NOT wait in the building during this rehearsal**.
- Due to the number of dancers we will have in the studio at one time for this rehearsal, <u>please</u>
 <u>do NOT bring any personal items into the studio</u> (dance bags, shoes, backpacks, purses,
 phones, etc.)

What to Bring to The Theater

- Dancers will be at the theater for several hours for Tech Rehearsal and Recital Day. Dancers will be in the dressing room for the duration of the Recital.
- To keep dressing rooms organized, we recommend having your dancer's items in a tote or large plastic container labeled with your dancer's name. Caboodles or tackle boxes are great for hair and makeup supplies.
- LABEL EVERYTHING WITH YOUR DANCER'S NAME!
- A cover-up to wear over their costume at all times. The dressing rooms are often cold, so we recommend bringing warm layers.
- A towel or blanket to sit on while they are waiting in the dressing room.
- Extra hair supplies (hair spray, bobby pins, etc.) and make-up (lipstick, eye shadow, eye liner, blush, mascara, etc.) Students may **NOT** share makeup for hygienic reasons.
- A bottle of water labeled with student's name.
- Quiet, clean activities to keep dancers occupied, such as coloring/reading books (NO MARKERS), simple board games (easily cleaned up), cards, etc.
- Electronics (phones, tablets, etc.) are permitted. **Keep in mind that lost/stolen items are not** the responsibility of AIM, our staff, or our volunteers.

Tech Repearsal at the Theater

Saturday, June 3rd

- <u>THESE ARE MANDATORY REHEARSALS.</u> Dancers who do not attend will not be permitted to perform. Email casey@artsinmotionda.com right away if you have any conflicts.
- Full costume, hair, and makeup <u>ARE REQUIRED</u> for these rehearsals.
- Dancers must arrive and check-in <u>AT LEAST 30</u>
 <u>MINUTES BEFORE THEIR FIRST SCHEDULED</u>
 REHEARSAL.
- Dancers arrive with hair and makeup done, wearing their costume for their first scheduled rehearsal.
 Bring the rest of your costumes with you in their provided garment bags.
- <u>ALL DANCERS ARE REQUIRED TO PARTICIPATE IN</u> THE FINALE REHEARSAL.
- Students with a break longer than 90 minutes are permitted to leave the theater and return for their next rehearsal. Please make sure you let the checkin table know you're leaving. Come back at least 30 minutes before your next scheduled rehearsal, as we may run ahead of schedule.
- If your dancer is at the theater for several hours, they may bring a meal or a snack to eat. Please make sure this meal is light on the tummy and NOT MESSY, and do NOT eat while wearing a costume.
- While waiting to rehearse, dancers are required to stay together with their Class Mom.
- Students will be dismissed after their rehearsal time on stage. Parents must sign their dancer out from their Class Mom.
- All costumes and student belongings must be removed from the dressing rooms following rehearsal.
- The schedule is subject to change. Any changes will be released as early as possible.

- Dancers in Act I arrive at the theater NO LATER THAN 2PM.
- Dancers only in Act II arrive at the theater NO LATER THAN 2:30PM.
- Parents sign dancers in at the sign-in table. Parents who are not Class Mom volunteers may NOT enter the dressing rooms.
- All dancers arrive wearing their first costume, with hair and makeup already done. (See show order below.) Transport additional costumes in their garment bags.
- Dancers should eat a filling and healthy lunch before arriving.
- Dancers stay in the dressing rooms during the entire show. There will be dedicated staff and volunteers in the dressing rooms to help students change and keep them occupied.
- The show begins at 3pm and will be 2-3 hours long.

Sign In & Out Procedures

Sign in/out procedures are in place for the safety of our dancers, volunteers, and staff. Please read the details below so signing your dancer in and out goes smoothly on Recital day.

SIGNING IN:

- Parents sign dancers in at the sign-in table.
- When you sign in, one parent per family will receive a wristband with your child's last name. Only the parent with this wristband will be allowed to pick up their dancer(s) at the end of the show.
- Staff/volunteers will escort dancers from the sign-in table to their dressing room.
- Non-Class Mom parents/family members are NOT permitted in the dressing rooms at any time.
 This includes family members of Class Moms.

SIGNING OUT:

- ONLY THE PARENT WITH THE WRISTBAND IS PERMITTED INTO THE DRESSING ROOM AT THE END OF THE SHOW TO SIGN OUT THEIR DANCER(S).
- We ask for your patience and understanding when waiting to sign out your dancer. It is important
 that parents are quiet and paying attention to instructions from AIM staff during the sign-out
 process.
- Class Moms will double check that the name on the parent's wristband matches the name of the dancer. YOU MUST PHYSICALLY SIGN YOUR CHILD'S CLASS MOM'S SIGN-OUT SHEET IN ORDER TO PICK UP YOUR DANCER.
- Only parents with wristbands will be allowed to sign their dancers out from Class Moms. All other parents/audience members should wait outside or in the main lobby.
- Security and staff will be present to make sure all procedures are followed and unauthorized persons do not enter the dressing rooms.

Violeos

- Lowe Productions, a locally owned professional video production company, will be filming AIM's Recital and creating a digital download of the show.
- Each family will receive an email 9-12 weeks following the show with a link to download the full Recital video.
- The digital download of the Recital video is included in your Performance Fee.



- Every hard working dancer deserves a beautiful bouquet of flowers after their performance! For the convenience of our families, AIM sells gorgeous bouquets for pick up on Recital day.
- Flowers will go on sale online starting closer to Recital. Stay tuned for an email announcement.
